Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Glory to Jesus Christ!

With the blessing of Metropolitan Nicolae, the Romanian Orthodox Youth of the Americas (ROYA) announce its heritage trip for teenagers and young adults to Father Nicolae Tanase's Pro Vita Orphanage this summer. This trip will take place July 2 – July 28, 2018. The trip encompasses 5 days at Punta Monastery, 10 days of volunteer work, and a 10 day international camp at Oasa Monastery.

The purpose for the trip to Romania is to give time and aid to the orphanage run by Father Nicolae Tanase. This trip is also designed to give young adults an opportunity to deepen and live their faith through love, experience and action. Ten days will be spent at the orphanage and may include the following capacities:

\square Social and educational interaction with the orphans
☐ Repairs on orphanage buildings
☐ Farm work (ie apple picking, gathering hay, etc.)

Christ tells us "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me...for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me." (Matthew 25:40).

Enclosed you will find applications for the trip. The cost of the trip is \$600 USD and should be included with your application. Checks should be made out to St. Nicholas Church, and must specify "Heritage Trip" in the memo. This does not include your transportation to and from Romania; plane tickets and travel insurance are the participant's own responsibility. Please consider bringing spending or pocket money for souvenirs or other optional purchases. All money for the trip is the participant's responsibility. Youth who would like to participate but do not have the financial means should consider fundraising in their parishes. Please contact us if you need help and speak with your parish priest about the initiative. With the grace of God, fund raising is not as difficult as it may seem.

The trip begins with five days at Putna Monastery on July 3rd. However, those who require transportation to the monastery have the option of arriving at Henry Coanda Airport in Bucharest on July 2rd. We will arrange pick up from the airport on the 2rd and travel in a group to the monastery on the morning of July 3rd. The other option is to meet us directly at the monastery on the July 3rd. We will be returning to Bucharest on the 28th of July at night, so please book your returning flights for the 29th of July.

All applications MUST be postmarked by May 30, 2018. There are only thirty (30) places available for the team. Applications will be processed in the order received. If you do not have a current passport, you should apply for one immediately.

We pray that you will be able to join us on this ground-breaking trip to act upon the command of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Camp Rules, Regulations and Expectations

- 1. Consumption of alcoholic beverages, smoking, and use of any legal or illegal drugs by participants will not be permitted.
- 2. No firearms or weapons of any kind (including "Swiss Army" knives) will be permitted.
- 3. Under NO circumstances is any form of hazing permitted by campers or staff. Incidents of hazing shall be reported to the director & staff immediately.
- 4. Aggressive behavior between any persons will not be tolerated.
- 5. Participants should inform the staff of their whereabouts and remain in supervised areas at all times.
- 6. Defacing or willful destruction of any furniture, camp equipment, trees, camp grounds, cars or personal belongings of any other participant will not be tolerated. Violators will be responsible for full financial compensation of any damage.
- 7. Damages or breakage in the buildings, courts, or wash houses should be reported immediately to the director.
- 8. All campers are expected to assist with daily cleaning.
- 9. Rules of common courtesy should be observed such as: Males should not wear headgear inside, eating at mealtimes should not begin until after prayer, participants should remain in dining hall until closing prayers.
- 10. This is a Christian camp, all campers and staff are to wear appropriately modest clothing. Campers not following these guidelines will be asked to change clothes.
 - Girls are expected to wear skirts of knee-length (or longer).
 - During services, girls are expected to wear a headscarf as well.
 - NO low-cut blouses, tight or see-through clothing.
 - NO clothing with inappropriate wording and/or images.
 - The camp director reserves the discretion of determining if something is inappropriate for camp attire.
- 11. All individuals must participate in all day and evening events, unless under medical restrictions which should be explained on the camper health form and discussed with the camp nurse the first day of camp.
- 12. Inappropriate music will not be tolerated. Do not bring anything that contains vulgar, sexually explicit, racist and/or morally offensive lyrics, messages and/or images.
- 13. Gaming devices are strictly prohibited at camp.
- 14. Campers are allowed to use cameras, cell phones and recording devices in a courteous manner as long as this does not disrupt the normal operation of camp. Should the use of such devices become disruptive to the normal operation of the camp, the camp director and organizers reserve the rights to take such devices away until after camp.
- 15. After "Lights Out" no camper is permitted to leave his or her room without the permission.
- **★** Failure of any camper to comply with the camp rules listed above may result in expulsion from camp.

In regards to the above stated rules, I/we have read and understand these rules and have reviewed them with my/our child so that he/she also understands their content. If the situation arises whereby disobedience to these rules occur and the smooth running and proper administration of this encampment is affected which also results in the dismissal of my/our child from camp, I/we accept full responsibility to provide expedient transportation home for my/our child and accept all financial costs which may occur from these actions with no expense inflicted upon the encampment or any agent of the encampment and to include no refund of initial registration fees.
